In order to rock climb, you must provide me with the following no later than November 22<sup>nd</sup>:

- A signed copy of the attached release
- A check payable to "Troop 641" for the appropriate amount
- Your shoe size

I will be collecting this at each Tuesday meeting.

3. I willingly agree to comply with terms and conditions for participation. If I observe any unusual significant hazard during my or my child's presence or participation, I will remove myself, and my child from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest Mountain Madness representative.
4. By participating in or attending any activity in connection with this program, whether on or off the rock, I consent to the use of any photographs, pictures, film or video taken of my child or provided to me or my child for publicity, promotion, television, websites or any other use, and expressly waive any right of privacy, compensation, copyright or any other ownership right connected to same.
5. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS MOUNTAIN MADNESS CLIMBING SCHOOL, its officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct classes and instruction (RELEASEES), from any and all claims, demands, losses, and liability arising out of or related to any INJURY, DISABILITY OR DEATH MY CHILD MAY SUFFER, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
